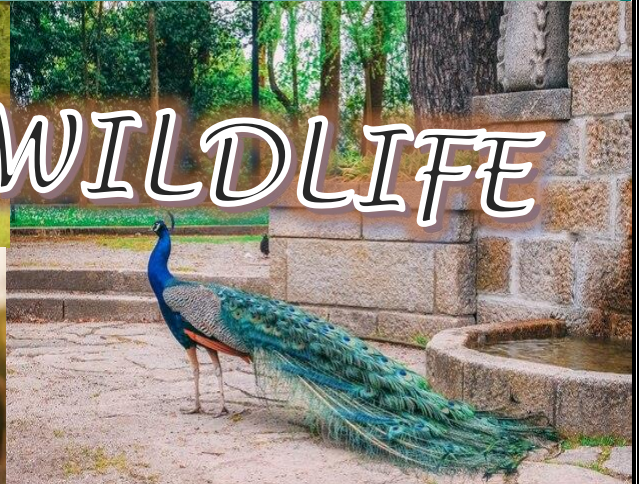
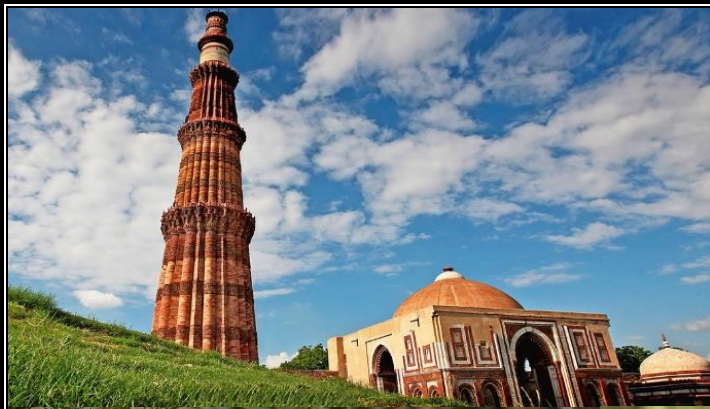
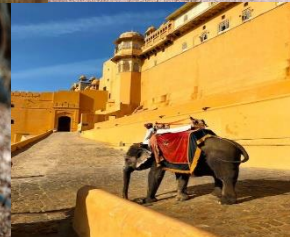

Day 01: Arrival Delhi (Flight: TBA) (No Meals)

- Welcome upon arrive at Delhi International Airport.
- Transfer and check in at the hotel.
- Stay overnight at hotel in Delhi.

Day 02: Delhi (B)

- Breakfast at hotel.
- Visit of Old Delhi - Jama Mosque, Raj Ghat & drive pass Red Fort.
- Cycle Rickshaw Ride at Chandni Chowk.
- Visit of New Delhi - India Gate, Parliament & President House.
- Also visit **National War Memorial**.
- Conclude the day with visit to **Qutub Minar**.
- Lunch & dinner at local restaurants.
- Stay overnight at hotel in Delhi.

Day 03: Delhi - Corbett National Park (B/L/D) (approx. travel time 05 hrs)

- Early breakfast at hotel.



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- Travel to **Corbett** - park having highest tiger count in overall India.
- On arrival check in at hotel.
- Afternoon leave for three hour game drive- the best sighting of wildlife.
- **Shambar** road is the best place to spot tiger.
- Stay overnight at hotel in Corbett.

Day 04: Corbett National Park (B/L/D)

- Enjoy early morning jeep safari at Corbett National Park.
- Further after, breakfast at hotel.
- Afternoon enjoy another safari at Park.
- Lunch & dinner hotel itself.
- Stay overnight at hotel in Corbett.

Day 05: Corbett – Dudhwa National Park (B/L/D) (approx. travel time 06 hrs)

- Early breakfast at hotel.
- Travel to **Dudhwa** – home of several endangered species.
- On arrival check in at hotel.
- Stay overnight at hotel in Dudhwa.

Day 06: Dudhwa National Park (B/L/D)

- Enjoy early morning jeep safari at Dudhwa National Park.
- Further after, breakfast at hotel.
- Afternoon enjoy another safari at Park.
- Lunch & dinner hotel itself.
- Stay overnight at hotel in Dudhwa.

Day 07: Dudhwa – Kishanpur Wildlife Sanctuary – Dudhwa (B/L/D)

- Early/packed breakfast at hotel.
- Excursion to **Kishanpur Wildlife Sanctuary** – famous for its rich biodiversity.
- Morning & noon safari at **Kishanpur Wildlife Sanctuary**.
- Evening back to Dudhwa.
- Stay overnight at hotel in Dudhwa.

Day 08: Dudhwa – Katarniaghat Wildlife Sanctuary (B/L/D) (approx. travel time 03 hrs)

- Breakfast at hotel.
- Drive to **Katarniaghat Wildlife Sanctuary** –
- On arrival, check in to the camp & have lunch.
- Afternoon enjoy jeep safari at **Kishanpur Wildlife Sanctuary**.
- Stay overnight at camp in Katarniaghat Wildlife Sanctuary.

Day 09: Katarniaghat – Lucknow (B/L/D) (approx. travel time 4.5 hrs)

- Early/packed breakfast at hotel.
- Travel to **Lucknow** - the capital of Uttar Pradesh.
- Visit the famous highlights of city- Bada Imambara, Chota Imambara & Govt. Musuem.
- Later, **enjoy heritage walk** across the lanes and by lanes of the chowk of Lucknow.
- Dinner & overnight stay at Lucknow.

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Day 10: Lucknow – Agra (B/L/D) (approx. travel time 4.5 hrs)

- Breakfast at hotel.
- **Enjoy Tonga ride** at the old part of the city.
- Later travel to **Agra** – home to India's most famous landmark, the Taj Mahal.
- On arrival check into the hotel.
- Stay overnight at hotel in Agra.

Day 11: Agra – Fatehpur – Bharatpur (B/L/D) (approx. travel time 1.5 hrs)

- Morning after breakfast travel to **Bharatpur**.
- En-route visit **Fatehpur Sikri** - a UNESCO World Heritage site.
- Also visit other monuments in complex: **Diwan-e-Khas & Panch Mahal**.
- After lunch continue travel to Bharatpur.
- On arrival check in at hotel.
- Evening enjoy safari at **Keoladev National park**.
- Stay overnight at hotel in Bharatpur.

Day 12: Bharatpur – Ranthambore (B/L/D) (approx. travel time 05 hrs)

- Early morning safari at **Bharatpur bird sanctuary** by Rickshaw ride.
- Afterwards come back to hotel for breakfast.
- After breakfast drive by surface to **Ranthambore**.
- Afternoon arrive and check-into hotel for lunch.
- After lunch go for a **safari** in Ranthambore national park by **canter**.
- Dinner & Overnight stay at Ranthambore.

Day 13: Ranthambore (B/L/D)

- Enjoy early morning **jeep safari at Ranthambore National Park**.
- Further after, breakfast at hotel.
- Afternoon enjoy another safari at Park.
- Lunch & dinner hotel itself.
- Stay overnight at hotel in Ranthambore.

Day 14: Ranthambore – Jaipur (B/L/D) (approx. travel time 04 hrs)

- Morning after breakfast travel to **Jaipur** – the first planned city of India.
- On arrival check-in at hotel.
- Proceed for early lunch at local restaurant.
- Evening enjoy jeep safari at **Jhalana Leopard Reserve**.
- Dinner & Overnight stay at Jaipur.

Day 15: Jaipur – The Pink City (B/L/D)

- Breakfast at hotel.
- Excursion to **Amber Fort** - famous for its stunning architecture & cultural significance.
- **Enjoy elephant ride** while climbing to Amer Fort.
- Later visit Jal Mahal or Water Palace (exterior only).
- Afternoon visit **City Palace Museum**.
- Drive pass visit **Hawa Mahal** or the 'Palace Of The Winds'.
- Conclude your day with visit to **Jantar Mantar**.
- Dinner & Overnight stay at Jaipur.

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Day 07: Jaipur – Delhi + Departure (B/L/D) (approx. travel time 06 hrs)

- Breakfast at hotel & then travel towards Delhi.
- On arrival, proceed for lunch at local restaurant.
- Evening free for shopping at famous markets of Delhi.
- Dinner at local restaurant.
- Afterwards, transfer to Delhi airport for departure.

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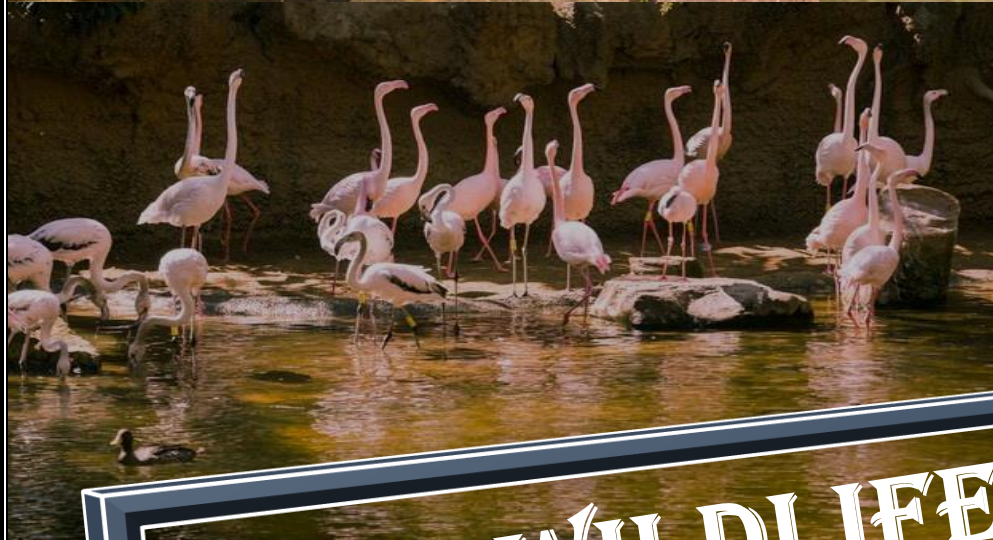

ITINERARY:

Day 01: Arrival Delhi (Flight: TBA) (No Meals)

Arrive at Delhi International Airport. Please clear immigration and visa formalities, collect your baggage and proceed to the arrival lounge through the green channel. MAGADH TRAVELS executive will wait at the arrival hall with a placard in your name to greet you. Thereafter you will be assisted with a transfer and check in at the hotel. Stay overnight at hotel in Delhi.

Day 02: Delhi – Agra (B/L/D) (approx. travel time 04 hrs)

Morning after breakfast travel to Agra, home to India's most famous landmark, the Taj Mahal. A poem of white marble, the Taj is described as the most extravagant monument ever built for love. On arrival visit of **Taj Mahal (closed on Fridays)**, a UNESCO Heritage Site, undisputedly one of the world's most beautiful buildings. The epitome of love, stands on the banks of the river Yamuna built in the 17th century by the Mughal Emperor Shahjahan. The white marble building changes its hue with the variations in the daylight. Made entirely of white marble and decorated with exquisite pietra dura (stone inlay) work, different types of precious and semi-precious stones were used in the intricate inlay work done on the interiors. This magnificent monument is built around a Charbagh or 'four garden' plan, split by watercourses— reflects the influence of Persian architectural style... an exquisite image that you'll remember forever. Then after visit of the **Agra Fort**, built in the year 1573 by Emperor Akbar, which is a mixture of the Islamic and Hindu styles of architecture. The fort remained as the main residence of the emperors belonging to the Mughal dynasty until the year 1638. The fort houses numerous impressive structures like the Jahangir Mahal, Khas Mahal, Diwan-i-Khass, Diwan-i-Am, Machchhi Bhawan and Moti Masjid. Stay overnight at hotel in Agra.

Day 03: Agra – Bharatpur (B/L/D) (approx. travel time 1.5 hrs)

Early morning after breakfast travel to **Bharatpur**. On arrival, check in at your hotel. Proceed for **rickshaw safari** at the **Keoladeo National park**; is the royal hunting preserve of the Bharatpur princes but now it has become one of the famous bird sanctuaries that is the abode of about 400 varied species of birds including water birds, exotic migratory birds from Afghanistan, Siberian cranes from the Arctic, Greyleg Geese from Siberia and Bareheaded Geese from China. Lunch at hotel. Evening free at leisure. Dinner and overnight stay at hotel.

Day 04: Bharatpur – Ranthambore (B/L/D) (approx. travel time 05 hrs)

Early morning safari at **Bharatpur bird sanctuary** by **Rickshaw ride**. Afterwards come back to hotel for breakfast. After breakfast drive by surface to **Ranthambore**. The Ranthambore national park was the private hunting reserves of the royal family of Jaipur till 19th century. In 1973 it was comes under scam of tiger Project. And in 1980 with an area of 282.03 sq. kms. of the inner part of Sawai Madhopur sanctuary declared as national

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park. Afternoon arrive and check-into hotel for lunch. After lunch go for a safari in Ranthambore national park by **Canter**. After safari return back to hotel. Dinner & Overnight stay at hotel.

Day 05: Ranthambore – Jaipur (B/L/D) (approx. travel time 04 hrs)

Morning after breakfast travel to **Jaipur**, the first planned city of India, is a treasure-trove of culture, art and history, famous for its colour, life style and Rajasthani cuisine. It is a city exuding royal heritage and extravagant richness. The historic city also has many temples and shrines. On arrival check-in at hotel. Visit **Jawahar Circle - Patrika Gate**; the entrance of Jawahar Circle is through the **Patrika gate**, which has been designed beautifully. If you ever feel the need to get back in touch with the traditional side of Jaipur but are scared to go to the crowded walled city because of the traffic, this is the place to visit. This gate has been made keeping in mind the other 7 gates which are present in the walled city.

Evening enjoy visiting **local bazaar** at walled city. Jaipur is a city of vibrant colours and markets (bazaars) of Jaipur verify this fact. Jaipur's colourful markets offer a great break to stop and shop on you tour. Usually tourists include shopping and visiting the lively markets of Jaipur in their itinerary. While moving through the markets, you will come across the vivacious culture of this region. Jaipur is the perfect place to shop for Handicrafts, antiques, jewellery, gems, pottery, carpets, textiles, metal work and leather ware. Stay overnight at hotel in Jaipur.

Day 06: Jaipur – The Pink City (B/L/D)

Morning after breakfast excursion to **Amber Fort** – 10 kilometers from main city, **Enjoy jeep ride** while climbing up to the main entrance of Amber Fort. The ancient capital of Jaipur state and the majestic palace complex to witness a unique system of air-conditioning of 17th century. The fort presents a fascinating blend of Hindu and Muslim architecture. It is built using red sandstone and white marble. While driving back to city photo stop at **Jal Mahal** known as a water palace. This low-rise symmetrical palace, that once was a shooting lodge for the Maharajah, appears to float in the centre of Sagar Lake.

Afternoon city tour of Jaipur pink city covering **City Palace Museum**; boasts to have some of the priceless handwritten Hindu scriptures of the ancient past, miniature delicate paintings, preserved painted ceilings and the elephant saddles (haudas), and is registered in the Guinness Book of Records to contain the biggest silver objects in the world. Drive pass **Hawa Mahal** or the 'Palace Of The Winds' – a remarkable gem of Rajput style of architecture. This beautiful Mahal decorated with fine lattice windows and screened balconies was to facilitate the royal women, in getting a glimpse of the daily events, royal processions and festivals taking place on the streets. Conclude your day with visit to **Jantar Mantar**; one of the famed observatories built by Sawai Jai Singh is a complex of astronomical instruments, chiseled out of stone which provides fairly accurate information to this day. Stay overnight at hotel in Jaipur.

Day 07: Jaipur – Delhi + Departure (B/L/D) (approx. travel time 06 hrs)

Breakfast at hotel & then travel towards Delhi. On arrival, proceed for lunch at local restaurant. Later afternoon visit of New Delhi which will include photo opportunities at some of the following attractions - the exterior of the **Parliament**, the War Memorial Arch (**India Gate**) and residence of the **President House** of India in New Delhi. Also visit **National War Memorial**. Conclude your day with visit to 72 meter high **Qutub Minar**; being one of the most important landmarks of Delhi, with calligraphically decorated interiors and also inscriptions of verses of the Holy Quran. Dinner at local restaurant. Later, timely transfer to airport to board the scheduled flight for onward destinations.

ITINERARY:

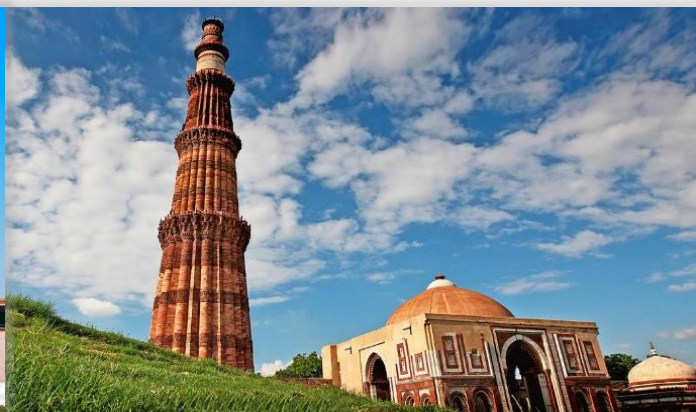
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Arrive at Delhi International Airport. Please clear immigration and visa formalities, collect your baggage and proceed to the arrival lounge through the green channel. MAGADH TRAVELS executive will wait at the arrival hall with a placard in your name to greet you. Thereafter you will be assisted with a transfer and check in at the hotel. Stay overnight at hotel in Delhi.

Day 02: Delhi (B)

Morning after breakfast enjoy the guided visit of Old Delhi covering **Jama Mosque** – the largest mosque in India built in red sandstone. Between the mosque and Chandni Chowk is a narrow shop-lined street along which you will be transported by **cycle rickshaws** on your most photogenic journey of the tour. Drive pass the **Red Fort**. While driving back to New Delhi visit **Raj Ghat** – a memorial that is dedicated to Mahatma Gandhi. The ghat is located in the banks of River Yamuna. It is a black marble platform that is built at the spot of cremation of Mahatma Gandhi, the father of the nation.

Afternoon visit of New Delhi which will include photo opportunities at some of the following attractions - the exterior of the **Parliament**, the War Memorial Arch (**India Gate**) and residence of the **President House** of India in New Delhi. Also visit **National War Memorial**. Conclude your day with visit to 72 meter high **Qutub Minar**; being one of the most important landmarks of Delhi, with calligraphically decorated interiors and also inscriptions of verses of the Holy Quran. Stay overnight at hotel in Delhi.



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Day 03: Delhi – Khajuraho (By Flight) + Panna (B) (approx. travel time 1.5 hrs)

Morning after breakfast transfer to Delhi airport to board your schedule flight to **Khajuraho**. Assisted arrival at Khajuraho airport and transfer to local restaurant for lunch. Then drive towards **Panna**- city of temples as the city has many ancient & beautiful temples. The city is famous for the diamond mines & also known because of the **Panna Tiger Reserve**. On arrival, check in to the hotel. Dinner & overnight stay at hotel in Panna.

Day 04: Panna (B/L/D)

Early **morning and afternoon shared jeep safari** at Panna National Park. Stay overnight at hotel in Bandhavgarh. Panna National Park is the residence for numerous endangered species like Royal Bengal Tigers, Leopards, Hyena, etc. The park is home to nearly 200 species of migratory birds. The park is worldwide famous for its tigers, deer & antelopes. Covering an area of approx. 542.67 sq. kms, the park attracts tourists not because of rich wildlife only but also for numerous historical sites. One can get the opportunity to witness the stone paintings which take you back to the Neolithic era. Dinner & overnight stay at hotel in Panna.



Day 05: Panna – Bandhavgarh (B/L/D) (approx. travel time 05 hrs)

Morning after breakfast travel to Bandhavgarh National Park and check in at hotel. During your journey you will cross through the rural areas and roads to witness the tribal culture and their lifestyle. Witness the local village market (**HAAT**) where still the traditional trading methods are used. Bandhavgarh National Park, the crown in the wildlife legacy of Madhya Pradesh. It is a natural habitat to wide range of flora and fauna. The park is nestled in the foothills of undulating Vindhya mountain range of Central India featuring hills and ravines. It is undoubtedly a gift of nature. On arrival check in at hotel. Stay overnight at hotel in Bandhavgarh.



Day 06: Bandhavgarh (B/L/D)

Early **morning and afternoon shared jeep safari** at Bandhavgarh National Park. Bandhavgarh is best known for having the highest density of Tigers in India. However, the beauty of its forests also lies in the rich wildlife that lives within it – Leopard, Sambar Deer, Barking Deer and many more. The park also has a rich variety of birdlife. You are likely to spot beautiful species of Egrets, Hornbills, Kingfishers and Eagles that are endemic to

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the region. We will explore the Tiger Reserve mainly by following a network of jeep tracks that will lead us into the forested areas. Our excursions in the Tiger Reserve will be by jeeps. As well as making early morning and afternoon excursions we will have periods of relaxation back at our lodge; these are especially welcome during the midday heat. Stay overnight at hotel in Bandhavgarh.

Day 07: Bandhavgarh – Kanha (B/L/D) (approx. travel time 05 hrs)

Morning after breakfast travel to Kanha National Park. Spread across 940 sq.km, Kanha National Park is one of the largest parks in Madhya Pradesh where the majestic royal Bengal tigers are found in good numbers. The Park is respected globally for saving the Barasingha from near extinction. No doubt, it is one of the best managed parks in Asia and a part of Project Tiger. National Geographic's award winning 'Land of the Tigers' was shot here, but the park is home to leopards, wild dogs and Barasingha as well. A safari in Kanha will surely get you thrilled, the way you were on your first trip to the zoo, as a child. On arrival check in at hotel. Stay overnight at hotel in Kanha.



Day 08: Kanha (B/L/D)

Early morning and afternoon shared jeep safari at Kanha National Park. **Kanha National Park** is the land of the herbivorous and the carnivorous animals. The varieties of animals can be discovered in abundance at this amazing reserve. It is the only habitat of the rare hard ground Barasingha, often referred as "the jewel of Kanha" and most famed the Indian Tigers. Tiger, Panther, Chital, Sambar, Barasingha, Black buck, Barking deer, Chowsingha, Jackal, Sloth bear, Wild dog. The Reserve brings around 300 species of birds and the most commonly seen birds are the Black Ibis, Bee-eaters, Cattle Egret, Blossom-Headed Parakeets, White-breasted Kingfisher, White-browed Fantail Flycatcher, Wood shrikes and Warblers among many more. Thousands of bird watchers and ornithologists can get attracted to this amazing bird paradise. The mixed, bamboo and the grassy forests are the perfect spots for bird watching in Kanha National Park. Stay overnight at hotel in Kanha.

Day 09: Kanha (B/L/D)

Early morning and afternoon shared jeep safari at Kanha National Park. Lunch & dinner at hotel itself. Stay overnight at hotel in Kanha.

Day 10: Kanha – Pench (B/L/D) (approx. travel time 04 hrs)

Morning after breakfast travel to Pench National Park. Pench National park, nestling in the lower southern reaches of the Satpura hills is named after Pench River, meandering through the park from north to south. It is located on the southern boundary of Madhya Pradesh, bordering Maharashtra, in the districts of Seoni and Chhindwara. Pench National Park, comprising of 758 sq. kms, out of which a core area of 299 sq. km is the national park and remaining 464 sq. km is the buffer area. On arrival check in at hotel. Lunch & dinner at hotel itself. Stay overnight at hotel in Pench.

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Day 11: Pench (B/L/D)

Early morning and afternoon shared jeep safari at Pench National Park. **Pench National Park is very rich in fauna** – Some of these are:- Tiger, Leopard, Jungle Cats, Sloth Bear, Wild Dog, Jackal, Wolf, Hyena, Fox, Wild Boar, Langoor, Monkey, Indian Gaur (Bison), Sambhar, Barking Deer, Spotted Deer, Porcupine etc. Also there are many species of reptiles found at Pench national Park – Snakes, Monitor Lizard etc. More than 300 species of residential and migratory birds can be seen at Pench national Park. Lunch & dinner at hotel. Stay overnight at hotel in Pench.



Day 12: Pench – Nagpur + Delhi (By Flight) (B/L/D)

Morning after breakfast transfer to Nagpur airport to board your schedule flight to Delhi. On arrival at airport transfer to hotel. Rest of the day at your leisure to enjoy the hotel services or you can go for shopping in nearby local markets. Evening dinner at local restaurant. Stay overnight at hotel in Delhi.

Day 13: Delhi + Departure (B)

Morning after breakfast transfer to Delhi international airport to board your schedule flight to onward destination.
